



# Club Facilities **Funding Program**

In season 2008-2009, the Western Australian Cricket Association will make available \$30,000 to local cricket clubs and associations for the development of playing and training facilities.

### **What types of projects are funded?**

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Funding is provided for the upgrade or development of synthetic playing and training facilities.

### **What is the average funding amount for successful applications per club / association?**

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The average project funding amount is in the vicinity of between \$500 - \$2500, however larger projects can be applied for and will be judged on merit.

### **What should be included with your application?**

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All applications should contain:

- Full detailed project budget
- Written endorsement of the relevant project by the clubs/associations Local Government Authority (regardless of any joint funding)
- Written endorsement of the Association if Club is applying.
- Written endorsement of the Education Department if a school
- Detailed plans of the project including written quotes etc.
- Any other information in support of the application

### **When do applications close?**

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Completed applications are to be forwarded to the Western Australian Cricket association by no later than 31 May 2008.

### **How are applications assessed?**

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The WACA will assess and advise both successful and unsuccessful applicants by the 15 June 2008.
