



WARRIOR & FURY SHIELD CARNIVAL OUTLINE



WHAT IS THE WARRIOR/FURY SHIELD?

The Warrior/Fury shield carnival is a one day lightning carnival which introduces participants to the modified cricket format, Super 8s. Each player has equal chance to bat, bowl, wicket keep and field in this non-threatening environment.

HOW DOES YOUR SCHOOL GET INVOLVED?

Ideally look to form a division in your existing Physical education network and discuss the idea of the holding a carnival. Your Community Cricket Officer is also available to provide assistance in contacting schools if required.

TEACHER INVOLVEMENT

Each carnival requires a teacher to act as the carnival Coordinator and is responsible for communicating all information to the schools and also the WACA. Duties required to undertake include;

- Book venue
- Provide schools with information on Rules and Fixture's
- Provide the score sheets on the day of the carnival along with the set up of grounds
- Provide all necessary information to WACA community cricket Officer

Teachers in charge at participating schools are responsible for ensuring that their teams are organized, aware of the game rules and how to score. It is essential that players are involved in practice games prior to the carnival, this is also a good way for teachers to learn how to score. Every team entered from a school **MUST** have a teacher/parent to assist in scoring, umpiring and general coaching.

WACA COMMUNITY CRICKET OFFICER ASSISTANCE

The following assistance is provided by the WACA;

- Cricket Officer to provide the coordinator with an information pack
- 1 x Warrior Shield for boys division and 1 x Fury shield for girls division
- Community Cricket Officer to present winning schools with shields at their next all school assembly
- Each entered team will be given a "Kookaburra Supa softa" ball to use as a match ball and also to keep
- Community Cricket Officer will attend on the day at some stage if available and will hand out giveaways and assist with general duties
