CLUB CRICKET

- **Traditional Club Comp (senior):** for those who want to play “Proper” Cricket. Players wear whites & represent district clubs. Teams play a mixture of one-day and Twenty20 formats.
Grades Available: A & B Grade Training Night: Thursday Matches Played: Sunday
- **Traditional Club Comp (junior):** for those who want to play “Proper” Cricket. Players wear whites & represent district clubs or school. Teams play either 30overs or 24overs a-side.
Grades Available: U17, U15 & U13s Training Night: contact club Matches Played: U15 & U17 = Sat, U13 = Sun
- **Coaches Network and Ambassador Recognition & Training Program (CN & ART):** The WACA invites female team coaches and ambassadors to attend “workshops” in order to continue their development, recognise their contribution, and provide assistance as clubs continue towards sustainability.

SCHOOL CRICKET

- **Representative:** individual players can trial for the SHS Rep match which is held in March each year, 2 teams are selected; North v South.

Events

- **Fun to Fury Clinic;** held alongside the first round of Fury matches (Nov) each year, this FREE clinic is an opportunity for girls aged 5 – 13 to come & try cricket. Each girl will receive a special Cricket show bag and will get the chance to meet the Fury players and go through some fun cricket activities with the players and the WACA staff. This is a great way for girls to try the game & get involved in a team with friends over the summer.
- **Local Club Programs;** This is a specialized program for young girls, providing a fun, comfortable & local environment to learn cricket skills and play a range of fun, interactive matches with a bunch of friends. Each district & or zone runs their own local girls competition or program, commonly called a **Boy Free Zone**
- **Girls Beach Day;** Always a popular event. Held at the end of each cricket season in March, lots of girls (&Parents) head down to the beach for a range of sand based cricket activities, including classic catches, big hits and of course a game of beach cricket, all followed with a BBQ to finish.

SIXERS

- BRAND new competition with all the Great parts of cricket “without the BORING”! Games take 1hour, are played under lights on Monday evenings, and the rules encourage everyone to have a go. There is a division for everyone... you can form your own team with 6 mates (work, school, winter sport) or you can register yourself and meet some new people.
- Divisions Available :
 - Girls:** (U13) 6pm -7pm
\$8 per player/ per game
 - Family Fun:** 7.10pm – 8.10pm
\$2 per player/ per game
*comp for daughters, mums, dads & brothers.
 - Opens:** 8.20pm – 9.20pm

NOTE: For Season 2009-10 the WACA will pilot this competition at Mirrabooka Softball HQ. In seasons to come there will be comps South & in Peel.

STATE CRICKET

- **Girls Country Cricket Carnival:** Teams from each country region participate in a 3 day carnival held in early January each year.
- **Female High Performance Camp:** The WACA invites approx 24 girls aged 15 and under from City and country areas to a 2-3 day camp, Held in either the April or July school holidays.
- **Rising Fury Squads:** The WACA Cricket officers form squads that train July – Oct each year, providing specialist coaching and focusing on developing the talented female cricketers in their zone or country region. This program is aimed at girls aged 12 – 15 and can lead into the WACA Female Premier League tournament and the State U17 training squad.
- **WACA Female Premier League (WFPL):** The WFPL has been set up to replicate playing conditions and competition intensity experienced when playing for WA at National Level. Teams are made up of players from within the Fury, Fury Development, U17 and the Rising Fury programs as well as individuals selected straight from “Club Land”.
 - 2 Divisions Available; The Emerging Players (EP) is a 3 day tournament in Sept/Oct school hols & Opens matches are scattered between Oct-Jan.
- **WA U17s:** A Development squad is selected in June each year they train between July – Dec with the National Championships played in Early/Mid January. Matches are a mixture of 45 over one-day and Twenty20 matches to win the Betty Butcher Shield.
- **Fury Development Squad:** This is a small elite Squad that is selected in June each year; these young women are identified as potential Fury players in the next few years. They train with the Fury Squad in order to fast track their development opportunities.
- **CAW CUP:** The Cricket Australia Women’s Cup is a 10 day competition held Nov/Dec each year. Commonly referred to as the 2nd XI tournament, State and Territories play matches under full WNCL playing conditions, providing players with a chance to push for selection at the highest level.
- **Western Fury:** Equivalent to the Retravisio Warriors the Western Fury is the pinnacle when representing your state. Home & Away matches are played between Nov – Feb each season. 2 Trophy’s are up for grabs, WNCL champions and Twenty20 Champions. The Twenty20 Final is broadcast live on Foxtel.
