



## Reciprocal Guest Pass application form

**Please note there is no reciprocal arrangement in place for the 2019 I.C.C. Cricket World Cup.**

### Eligibility

A Member of a Reciprocal Club may obtain a Reciprocal Guest Pass, which is limited to a single four-week period, free of charge, provided that they meet the following criteria:

- the Member is a full voting Member;
- the Member is over 16 years of age; and
- the Member does not work or maintain a residential address in the United Kingdom.

In the event that M.C.C. has any doubt that the Member does not meet the above eligibility criteria, further information may be requested, or the application for the Reciprocal Guest Pass may be denied, at the sole discretion of M.C.C.

Members are requested to please attach a copy of their Full membership card, Letter of Introduction from their Club, and evidence which confirms their residency outside the United Kingdom as part of the application.

List of acceptable supporting documents for residency purposes are:

- Household Utility Bill (which must be no more than 3 months old);
- Driver's Licence; or
- as otherwise agreed by M.C.C.

### Entitlements for Major Matches

**Pass:** Eligible Members of Reciprocal Clubs are entitled to a Reciprocal Guest Pass, which is limited to a single four-week period, free of charge, which provides the holder with complimentary entry to the Ground, Pavilion and unreserved seating in the Members' Friends' Enclosures for the following Major Match days at Lord's:

- Royal London One-Day Cup Final on Saturday 25th May 2019;
- England v. Ireland Test Match Days 2-4 on Thursday 25th, Friday 26th and Saturday 27th July 2019; and
- Middlesex Twenty20 Cup matches.

**Tickets:** Subject to availability, tickets for Major Matches can be pre-purchased by completing the Reciprocal Ticket Application Form included. Please note M.C.C. will not accept completed Reciprocal Ticket Application Forms via email. Rover tickets admit relatives or friends to unreserved seats in the Members' Friends' Enclosures, but not the Pavilion.

**All applications for a Reciprocal Guest Pass, which include any of the Major Match days listed above, must be received at least 7 days before the date that the relevant match begins. Failure to do so will result in the application for a Reciprocal Guest Pass being denied.**

### Entitlements for Matches at Lord's not listed above (Non-Major Matches)

**Pass:** Eligible Members of Reciprocal Clubs are entitled to a Reciprocal Guest Pass, limited to a single four-week period, free of charge, providing access to the Ground, Pavilion and Members' Friends' Enclosures for days of Non-Major Matches.

Completed applications for a Reciprocal Guest Pass must be received by M.C.C. prior to the first day for which the pass is requested, otherwise the Member may not be admitted to the Pavilion.

**Tickets:** Subject to availability, ground admission tickets for guests of the Member for days of Non-Major matches can be purchased from the Ticket Sales Window at the North Gate and/or Grace Gate entrances to the Ground.

Reciprocal Guest Pass holders will be entitled to introduce a guest into the Pavilion for days of Non-Major matches, subject to all parties meeting the dress regulations.

**If the Member's application for a Reciprocal Guest Pass is successful, he or she will receive a confirmation via email. This email will also include collection details for the Reciprocal Guest Pass and tickets, if relevant. No tickets or passes will be sent out via the post.**

Reciprocal Guests are not permitted to purchase or wear official M.C.C. Member merchandise.

### **Data Protection**

M.C.C. holds any personal data provided as part of an application for a Reciprocal Guest Pass for the purposes of administering and processing the Reciprocal Guest Pass application. M.C.C. will keep a copy of this application for no longer than is necessary to administer the application. M.C.C. ensures that all personal information is kept secure and safe. Individuals are entitled to receive a copy of their personal information held by M.C.C. on request and to correct any inaccuracies in it.
