Course Description

Lower School

At schools the four hour per week course covers:

- Interschool matches
- Interstate and international tours

Upper School

All schools offer Upper School University and TAFE bound courses to meet student needs. This includes the Physical Education Studies Course of Study and Certificate II in Sport and Recreation
